FAQ's

What is a dental implant?

A dental implant is a small titanium screw which replaces your tooth root. This is carefully and skilfully placed into your jawbone by a specially trained dentist.

How long does treatment take?

If you take into consideration the time taken from your initial consultation, until your implant site is completely healed, and depending on how



many implants you have - implant treatment can take anywhere from 3-12 months.

How much do dental implants cost?

At Archway Dental, an implant consultation is £150, and treatment is bespoke for each patient, this means the cost can vary, but a single implant with a crown will start from £2996.

How long do dental implants last?

Each case is different, but typically dental implants with good care will last ten years or longer.

Are dental implants painful?

Implants are placed with local anaesthetic, which ensures you will be numb during your appointment. Once this wears off, like any oral surgery you can feel some discomfort, this is normal and can be managed with over-the-counter pain relief.

Is there an age limit on having dental implants?

There isn't an age limit on dental implants as long as you have healthy gums and you are free of gum disease, however we generally advise that anyone under 18 is still growing and therefore would not be suitable.

How many teeth can be replaced with dental implants?

Dental implants can be used for a single missing tooth, or to create an entire mouth full of teeth too.
